AFTER YOUR EXAM

Your images are read by a radiologist, a medical doctor who specializes in the specific area of the body you had examined. Next, the radiologist prepares a diagnostic report to share with the doctor who sent you to us. Your doctor will consider this information in context of your overall care and talk with you about the results. Give your doctor's office a call if you have questions on next steps or follow-up appointments.
