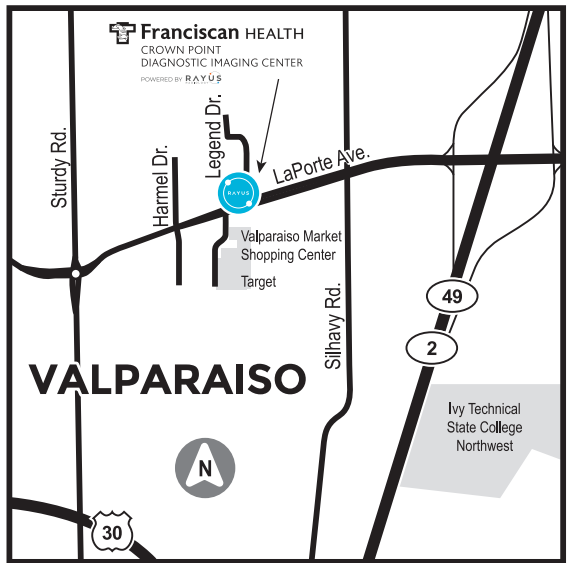

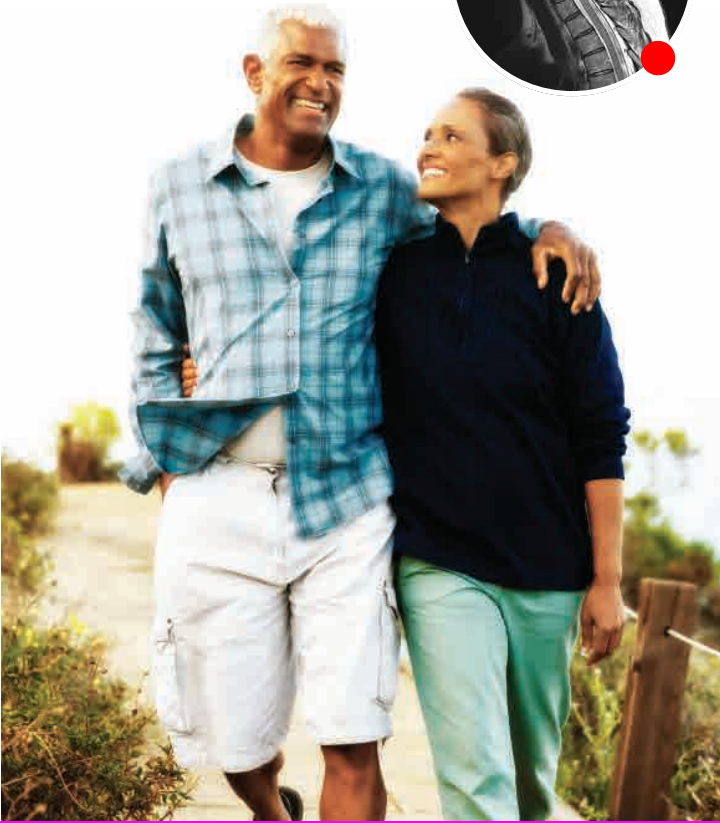

MRI

Magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) combines a powerful magnet with an advanced computer system and radio waves to produce accurate, detailed pictures of organs and tissues to diagnose a variety of medical conditions.

Our high-field wide-bore MRI is ideal if you are larger and/or claustrophobic. It provides one foot of space above your face and can accommodate up to 440 lbs.

CT

Computed tomography (CT) scanning is a rapid diagnostic exam that combines X-ray equipment and computers to create images of the inside of your body to assess your organs, blood vessels, abdomen and bones. This scan shows the location, nature and extent of many different diseases or abnormalities.

CARDIAC MRI

This exam captures multi-dimensional images of your beating heart to examine the structures and functions of your heart and major vessels.

ELECTROCARDIOGRAPHY (EKG)

EKG is a fast, painless way to help detect and diagnose heart conditions. Using electrode patches placed on your body, an EKG records your heart's electrical signals and produces them as a graph for your doctor to measure your heart's activity.

ULTRASOUND

Ultrasound is a safe and painless exam that uses a small probe on the outside of your skin to collect high-frequency sound waves and sends them to a computer to create images of the inside of your body.

X-RAY

X-ray is a quick and simple exam that produces images of the bony structures and soft tissue inside your body using a very small amount of radiation. This exam is used to assess injury (fractures or dislocations) or disease (bone degeneration, infections and tumors).
